The Air V&V Program was developed by the Guam Visitors Bureau to encourage those 12 years and older to get a COVID-19 vaccine while vacationing in Guam. Participants can choose from travel and tour packages that were developed in collaboration with Guam's travel trade, hotel, and tourism partners. This program is meant to jumpstart Guam's tourism industry while highlighting the warm Håfa Adai spirit and hospitality of the people of Guam. Taiwan Charter Flights



Guam Welcomes First Direct Flight from Taiwan in 2021 *Over 2,000 visitors expected for Air V&V program*

(July 6, 2021 – Tumon, Guam) The Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) and A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority welcomed Guam's first direct flight from Taiwan in more than a year and a half. The EVA Air charter flight carried 153 passengers to the island to participate in Guam's vaccination tourism program — Air V&V.

The EVA Air charter, an Airbus A321-200, is one of several flights that are coordinated by various Taiwan travel agencies, such as Lion Travel and Phoenix Tours. More than 2,000 visitors from Taiwan are expected in the months of July and August.

"This is just the beginning of the revival of Guam's number one industry," said GVB President & CEO Carl T.C. Gutierrez. "I would like to thank Governor Lou Leon Guerrero for supporting the Air V&V program, which gives visitors the opportunity to get vaccinated and also experience our Håfa Adai spirit."

GVB provided complimentary bottled water and hand sanitizer to passengers as they made their way from immigration to the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) checkpoint. Passengers were also greeted with live CHamoru music by Ruby Santos and Jesse Bais.

"I want to recognize the great collaboration between the Guam Taiwan Office, EVA Air, and other travel trade partners in making this charter flight a success," said GVB Director of Global Marketing Nadine Leon Guerrero. "We want to thank the Guam International Airport Authority, Guam Customs and Quarantine, Airport Police, and Public Health for their continued partnership in welcoming visitors to our beautiful island."

Guam Safe Certified is the official local designation, which identifies establishments that are in compliance and have care and pride in government health and safety guidelines.

The World Travel & Tourism Council (WTTC) created the first ever global safety and hygiene stamp. This stamp enables travelers to recognize destinations around the world that have adopted standardized health and hygiene protocols.

CURRENT ENTRY PROTOCOLS

Governor Lou Leon Guerrero signed **Executive Order No. 2021-13**, relative to amending restrictions for incoming travelers and quarantine facilities, and other conditions during Pandemic Condition of Readiness 3 (PCOR 3), and order such that:

- **QUARANTINE FOR INCOMING TRAVELERS.** Pursuant to applicable law and the Department of Public Health and Social Services Guidance (DPHSS), all incoming travelers shall be subject to quarantine at a government facility.
 - **EXEMPTION FOR VACCINATED TRAVELERS EXTENDED TO INDIVIDUALS WITH WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION (WHO) AUTHORIZED VACCINES.** Effective at 12:01AM on June 19, 2021, all incoming travelers who have been fully vaccinated with an FDA or WHO authorized COVID-19 vaccine (including, but not limited to, Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Johnson & Johnson/Janssen, and AstraZeneca), upon verification, are exempt from quarantine. Travelers availing of this exemption shall be required to self monitor for COVID-19 symptoms and comply with applicable DPHSS Guidance, including for verification requirements.
 - **UNVACCINATED TRAVELERS.** Effective at 12:01AM on June 19, 2021, incoming travelers who, upon 72 hours of arrival in Guam, present a negative PCR or antigen test taken within 72 hours of arrival, are eligible for home quarantine and self-monitoring as provided in applicable to DPHSS Guidance.

Executive Order No. 2021-15

4. QUARANTINE FOR INCOMING TRAVELERS. Pursuant to applicable law and DPHSS Guidance, all incoming travelers shall be subject to quarantine at a government facility.

- a. EXEMPTION FOR VACCINATED TRAVELERS.** Exemptions for vaccinated travelers provided in Executive Order No. 2021-13 continue to be in effect, subject to applicable DPHSS Guidance.
- b. EXEMPTION FOR TRAVELERS WITH NEGATIVE PCR TESTS.** Effective at 12:01AM on July 4, 2021, incoming travelers who, upon arrival in Guam, present a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours of arrival in Guam, are exempt from quarantine, subject to applicable DPHSS Guidance.
- c. TRAVELERS WITH NEGATIVE ANTIGEN TESTS.** Effective at 12:01 AM on July 4, 2021, incoming travelers who, upon arrival in Guam, present a negative antigen test taken within 72 hours of arrival in Guam, shall be subject to home quarantine and monitoring as provided in applicable DPHSS Guidance.
- d. REMAINING TRAVELERS.** Travelers who do not qualify for an exemption from quarantine or for home quarantine as provided herein or in applicable DPHSS Guidance shall be quarantined at a government facility as provided in applicable DPHSS Guidance.

- Mobile access to EDF launched
